Child and Youth Safe Organisations Act 2023

* indicates a required field

The Tasmanian Government has established a new and legally binding system to improve the safety and wellbeing of children and young people in organisations. This is known as the Child and Youth Safe Organisations Framework.

The [Child and Youth Safe Organisations Act 2023](#) came into effect on 1 July 2023, enabling the Framework to apply from 2024 onwards.

The Framework includes:

- Child and Youth Safe Standards; and
- a Reportable Conduct Scheme.

The Framework will legally apply to a wide range of Tasmanian organisations that engage with children and young people from 2023 onwards.

A dedicated independent oversight body called the Independent Regulator will regulate the Child and Youth Safe Standards and Reportable Conduct Scheme.

It is mandatory that all staff, contractors, venue users and volunteers complete Introductory safeguarding training.

RANT Arts Venue Hire Terms and Conditions

By booking the RANT venue, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Booking and Payment

- All bookings must be confirmed in writing.
- A deposit (if required) of \$100 must be paid to secure the booking.
- Full payment is due before the date of hire unless otherwise agreed. \$250 half day \$500 full day
- RANT may offer to waive hire fees at their discretion.
- Staff call-out fees and technical staff fees will be billed to you after the booking has concluded.

2. Cancellations

- Cancellations made more than 7 days before the booking date will receive a full refund.
- Cancellations made within 7 days of the booking may forfeit the deposit or be charged a cancellation fee.

3. Use of Venue

- The hirer may only use the venue for the agreed purpose and time.
- The venue must be left clean and in the condition it was found.
- RANT reserves the right to charge additional cleaning or repair fees if the venue is left in poor condition or damaged.

4. Access and Supervision

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- The hirer is responsible for all persons attending the venue during the hire period.
- Children and young people under 18 must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.

5. Health and Safety

- The hirer must follow all fire safety and emergency procedures.
- Exits must be kept clear at all times.
- Any incidents, damage, or injuries must be reported to RANT staff immediately.

6. Insurance and Liability

- RANT is not responsible for any loss or damage to personal property.
- The hirer is responsible for any damage caused to the venue or its equipment.
- Public liability insurance may be required for certain events.

7. Prohibited Activities

- No smoking or open flames inside the venue.
- No illegal activities or behaviour that may disturb neighbouring businesses or residents.

8. Right of Refusal

- RANT reserves the right to refuse or cancel a booking at its discretion.
